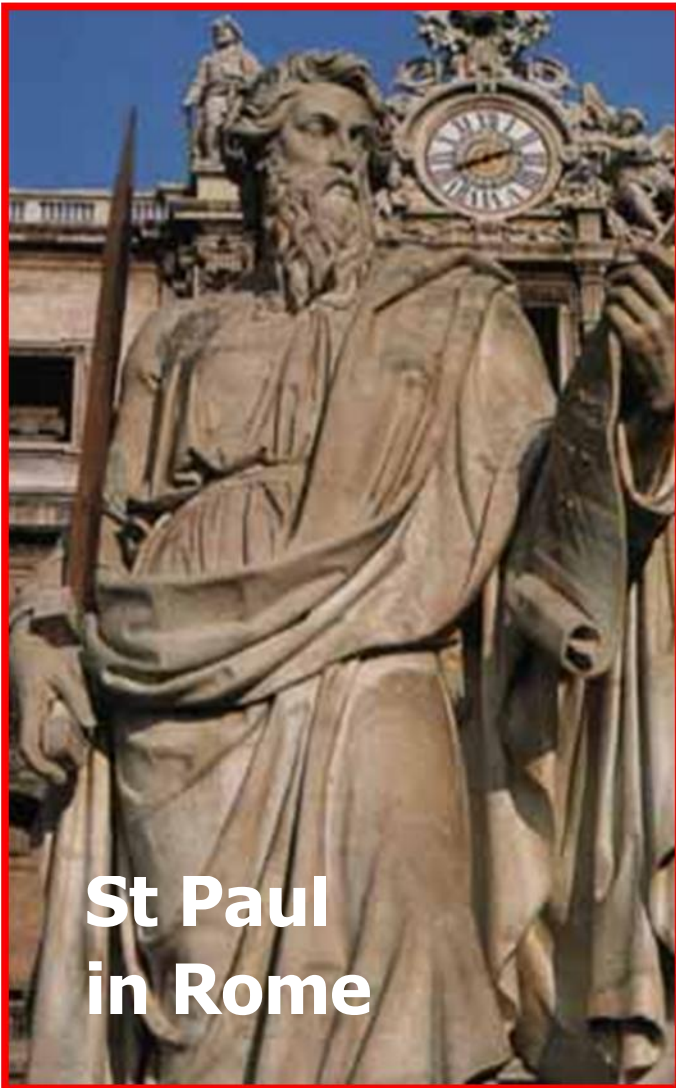

St Paul in Rome

In 2009 and 2010 the Society of Catholic Priests, founded in England in 1995, has formed provinces in North America and Australia. 2012 gives us the opportunity to take part in an historic step in our lives as we meet in conference in Rome.

Although the figure of St Peter dominates Rome there is little historic evidence that he went there. However, we know that St Paul wrote to the Christians in Rome, was taken there under arrest and died there. We will therefore be focusing on St Paul, his life, his teaching and his theology, during our days together under the direction of Dr Paula Gooder, renowned biblical theologian and teacher and the Ven Jonathan Boardman, Archdeacon of Italy and Malta and Chaplain to the Anglican Church of All Saints, Rome.

Conference Speaker

Dr Paula Gooder

Paula Gooder is a freelance writer and lecturer in Biblical Studies. After studying in Oxford, she spent 12 years in theological education (first at Ripon College Cuddesdon and that at the Queen's Foundation for Ecumenical Theological education, Birmingham, before making the move to freelance work. Her research areas include the writings of Paul, with a particular emphasis on 2 Corinthians and Mysticism, Biblical Interpretation and the Development of Ministry in the Early Church. Her recent publications include Searching for



Meaning: An Introduction to Interpreting the New Testament (SPCK, 2008), The Meaning is the Waiting: The Spirit of Advent (Canterbury Press, 2008), LentWise: Spiritual Essentials for Real Life (CHP, 2008), Reader Ministry Explored (SPCK, 2009), A Way through the Wilderness: God's Help in a Time of Crisis (CHP, 2009) This Risen Existence: The Spirit of Easter (Canterbury Press, 2009).

Paula is Canon Theologian both of Birmingham Cathedral and of Guildford Cathedral. She is a Reader in the Birmingham Diocese. She is a visiting lecturer at Kings College, London, an associate lecturer at St Mellitus, an honorary lecturer at the University of Birmingham and a Senior Research Scholar of the Queen's Foundation, Birmingham. She is a member of General Synod, the Archbishops' Faith and Order Advisory Group, the Women in Episcopacy Revision Committee and the Ministry Division's Quality in Formation Panel (with a particular brief for Reader Ministry).

Paula lives in Birmingham with her husband Peter and two daughters Susie and Ruth.
